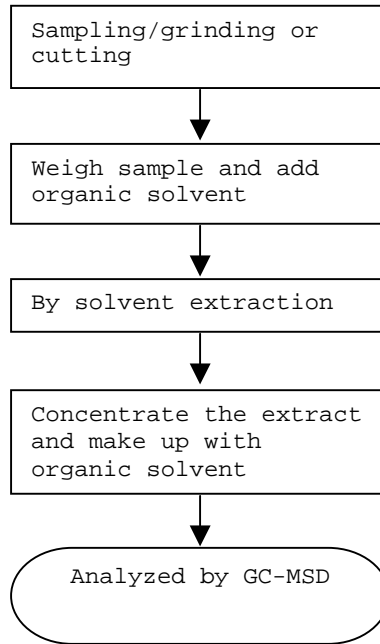

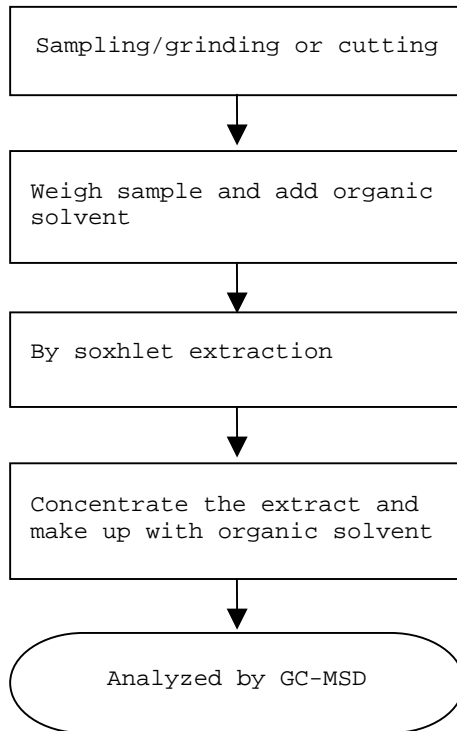

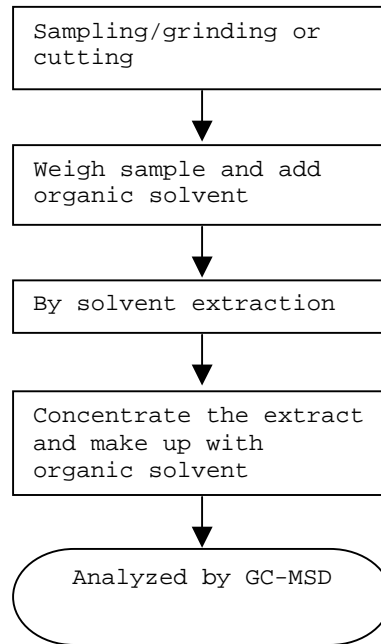

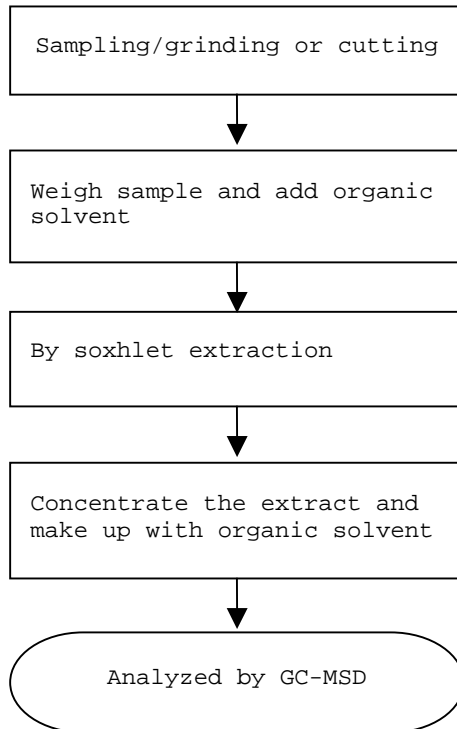
Test For Phthalates Contents

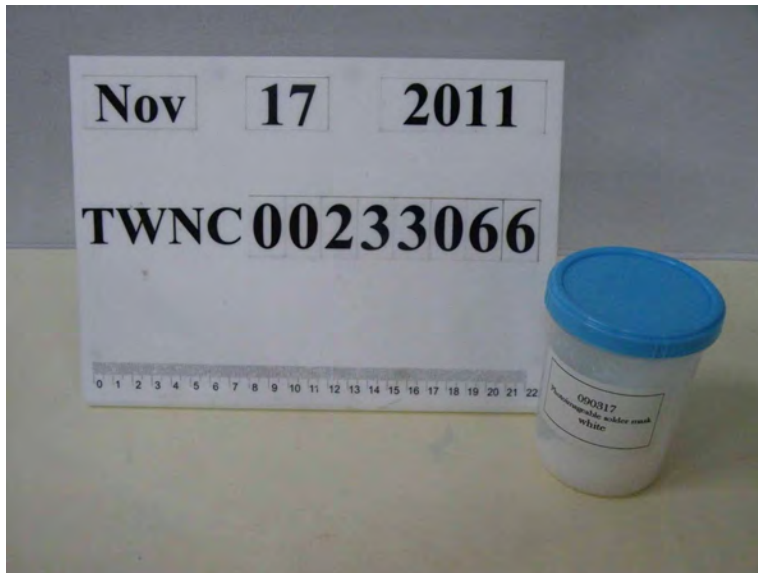

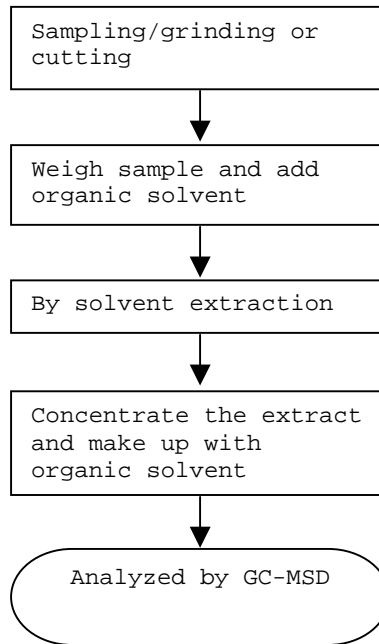

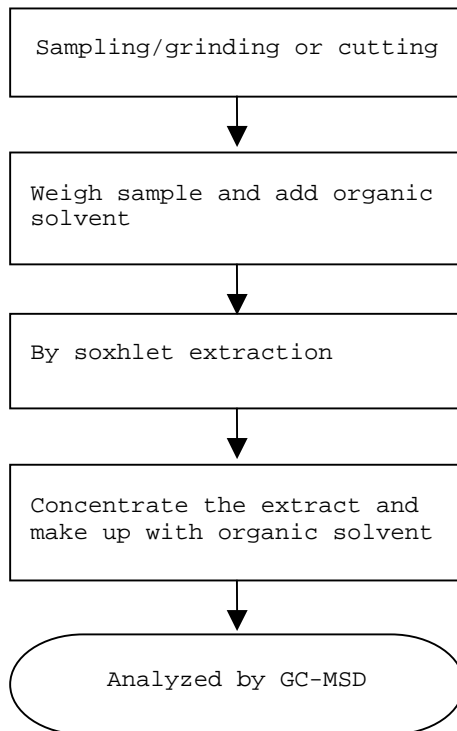
Test For Phthalates Contents
